- ... respect all players, coaches, referees and spectators*
- ... play to win but accept defeat with dignity*
- ... respect and play by the rules of the game*

Fans should...

- ... encourage players to play according to the rules*
- ... encourage and reward effort, fair play and commitment*
- ... refrain from negative attitude to players, referees, officials and other spectators*
- ... show respect for their teams' opponents*
- ... never influence the outcome of a game*
- ... stay in the spectators' section and refrain from entering the playing area*

- ... reject smoking, alcohol and drugs***
